Pursuant to Sections 15.2-2503, 15.2-2506, and 22.1-93 of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended, the Mathews County Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing on the proposed budget for Fiscal Year 2016 – 2017 at 7:00 p.m. Monday, April 18, 2016, in the historic Mathews County Courthouse, 27 Court Street, Mathews, Virginia.

No increases in the real property and personal property taxes are proposed.

All citizens of the County have the right to attend the public hearing and state their views on the proposed budget and tax rates subject to reasonable time limits and procedures established by the Board of Supervisors. Those persons requiring assistance during the public hearing due to physical or sensory disabilities must submit a written request detailing the assistance needed to the County Administrator's Office, P.O. Box 839, Mathews, Va. 23109 by 4:30 p.m., Friday, April 15, 2016. Written comments are also accepted by mail prior to the meeting or may be presented to the Board at the public meeting.
